The Agape Church of the Nazarene in Rustenburg recently had their 13th annual Kinderfees (Children's festival). This year wasn't different from previous years: God was on the move!!

Rev Danie Jacobs, Children's pastor reports: "At the Kinderfees, we work in groups according to the grades of the children, from pre-school to Grade 7. We had a total enrollment of 952 (804 children and 148 volunteer workers). Daily attendance was between 650-700 kids. Our theme for 2010 was Jesus Champs! We gave them some perspective on how God uses ordinary people in their circumstances, even if it is difficult – like Joseph and Esther. We made use of characters, dramas, dances, video-clips, music and preaching of the Word to minister to the kids. God blessed us in so many ways, we had enough money to provide for all our needs, and the kids could attend for free!

Senior Pastor, Rev Dawie de Koker says that more than 200 children received Christ as their personal Saviour during this weeklong outreach. "They are now being followed up, and invited to attend our church". At the closing ceremony on Sunday morning, hundreds of parents and children came, as Leane Weel (children's worker in Agape) presented the gospel one last time.
